Botanical Characteristics

Laperla is a very-early high yielding table potato with light yellow flesh and a very attractive light yellow smooth skin. Laperla is being grown in the early potato production area's and mainly marketed straight from the field. Partial resistant to potato cyst nematode *Globodera pallida* pathotype 2.
