

MONDEO

Markets for Mondeo are North Africa, South Europe and the Middle East.

Maturity:	Middle late / late
Tubers:	Mondeo has oval to long-oval tubers with light-yellow flesh and a nice clear skin, cookingtype B.
Seed treatment	Mondeo has an average dormancy and less topsprout dominance. Mondeo is average susceptible to sproutdamage. Planting in the white bud stage gives good results. Mondeo reacts very positive on Talent, in case of number of tubers. Seems to react negative to Ethyleen.
Planting Density:	Planting distance somewhat wider than Spunta; 70.000 plants per ha.
Soil:	Suitable to every soiltype. Mondeo has a good scap resistance.
Fertilization	Average N fertilization, comparable to Spunta; 120 kg per ha including soilreserve. Devided doses are preferred to avoid a too lush growth (of the foliage).
Weed control	Mondeo is less susceptible to Sencor.
Cultivation	Normal plantingdepth. Quick emergence and development which results in a rather high, good covering foliage. Average susceptible to Y-virus and moderate selectable. Mondeo can produce berries.
Defoliation	When the crop is rather mature, haulmkillling should not cause problems. A too lush growth makes an immature crop and more chance on regrowth (and virus risks).
Harvest	Mondeo needs time for skin setting; wait minimal three weeks after haulmkillling before harvesting. Mondeo is rather less susceptible to harves damage, but is susceptible to bruising. Harvest and handle with care.
Storage	Mondeo has an average dormancy. This variety seems susceptible to fusarium; a treatment with Imasalil after harvesting is adviced. Mondeo seems rather less susceptible to silverscab. Because of susceptibility for bruising, not grading under 10 ° C. Mondeo has a high turgor and is because of that susceptible to grading-damage. Handle with care!
