

Fianna

Botanical characteristics:

Growth	Tall to medium; fairly strong grower.
Flowers	White.
Tubers	Oval: pale yellow, smooth to medium smooth skin; white flesh, shallow eyes. Skin colour white.

Agronomical characteristics:

Growth period	100 - 120 days.
Yield	High: Similar to Bp1 especially when planted in spring.
Tuber size distribution	Large oval, uniform in shape.
Tuber appearance	Mostly large and medium sized tubers occur.
Tuber rest period	Long ; 70 - 90 days from natural foliage death until sprouting.

Consumer characteristics:

Eating quality	Fairly firm to floury, suitable for chips.
Processing quality	High relative density (SG) Suitable for processing to chips and frozen chips.
Keeping quality	Good: The internal quality of the tubers weakens gradually after natural foliage death.

Diseases:

Late Blight	Mildly susceptible.
Early blight	Mildly susceptible.
Viral diseases	Susceptible to leafroll and a good resistance to mosaic.
Common Scab	Mildly susceptible.
