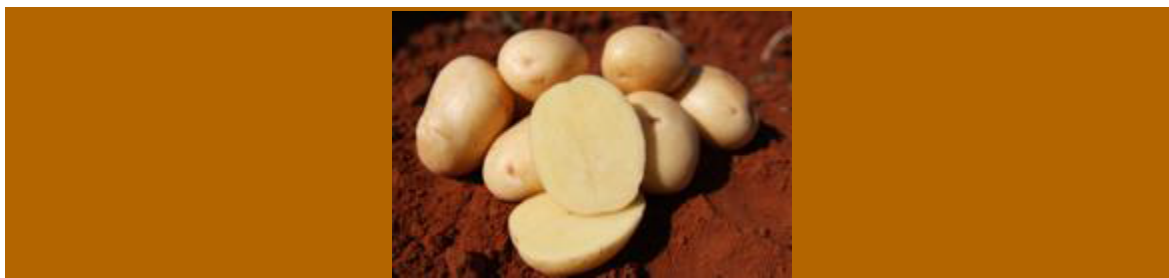


Lanorma



Place of Origin:	Lanorma is originally from the Netherlands and have been bred by Den hartigh.
Parents:	Bydand (mother) x Caesar (father).
License:	GWK is sub license holders and have sole plant breeders rights in South Africa.
Plant:	Plants are Medium to tall and grow very fast. Strong and hardy plant and a good cover are obtained. Inflorescent normal white flowers occur.
Maturity:	Short to medium grower and only grows 80-90 days from emergence till natural foliage die off.
Tuber shape and size:	Round to oval tubers with very shallow eyes. Tubers are very uniformed in size and have very low percentag small tubers.
Skin:	Skin is extremely smooth with a white to cream finish. Very suitable for prepack.
Flesh:	Flesh is xream to white with a fairly firm texture.
Yield:	Very high yield under favourable conditions. This variety bulks early with very uniformed tubers and low percentage small tubers. Very suitable for dry land conditions as it can tolerate a lot of heat and drought conditions.
Plant resistance:	Plants are slightly susceptible for blight on leaves as well as on tubers. Tubers have a very high resistance to common scab and are suitable for older fields.
